The resulting number of shares of Intel common stock acquired upon vesting of the Performance-based RSUs is contingent upon the achievement of pre-established performance metrics, as approved by the Company's Compensation Committee, over a three-year period beginning on the grant date and ending on the third anniversary of the grant date, unless that date falls on a date that the NASDAQ Stock Market is closed, in which case the next business date that the NASDAQ Stock Market is open shall apply.

Each Performance-based Restricted Stock Unit (RSU) represents the right to receive, following vesting, no less than 50% and no more

Unless earlier forfeited under the terms of the Performance-based RSU, each Performance-based RSU vests and converts into no less than 50% and no more than 200% of one share of Intel common stock three years and one month after the grant date (together with dividend equivalent shares thereon), unless that date falls on a non-business date, in which case the next business date shall apply.

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- (4) Each restricted stock unit represents the right to receive, following vesting, one share of Intel Corporation common stock.
 - Unless earlier forfeited under the terms of the RSU, 1/12th of the award vests and converts into common stock in twelve substantially
- (5) equal quarterly tranches, beginning on April 24, 2011. If the quarterly vesting date falls on a non-business date, the next business date shall apply.
