**Item 1.01 Entry Into a Definitive Material Agreement.**

On August 16, 2017, Andrea Electronics Corporation (the Company ) entered into a Settlement Agreement with Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. and Samsung Electronics America, Inc. (together, Samsung ). Under the Settlement Agreement the Company settled outstanding litigation between the Company and Samsung including *Andrea Electronics Corporation v. Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. and Samsung Electronics America, Inc.*, Civ. Action No. 2:16-cv-05217, pending in the Eastern District of New York and *Certain Audio Processing Hardware and Software and Products Containing the Same*, Inv. No. 337-TA-1026, pending at the International Trade Commission. In addition, the Company and Samsung entered into a Patent License Agreement.
